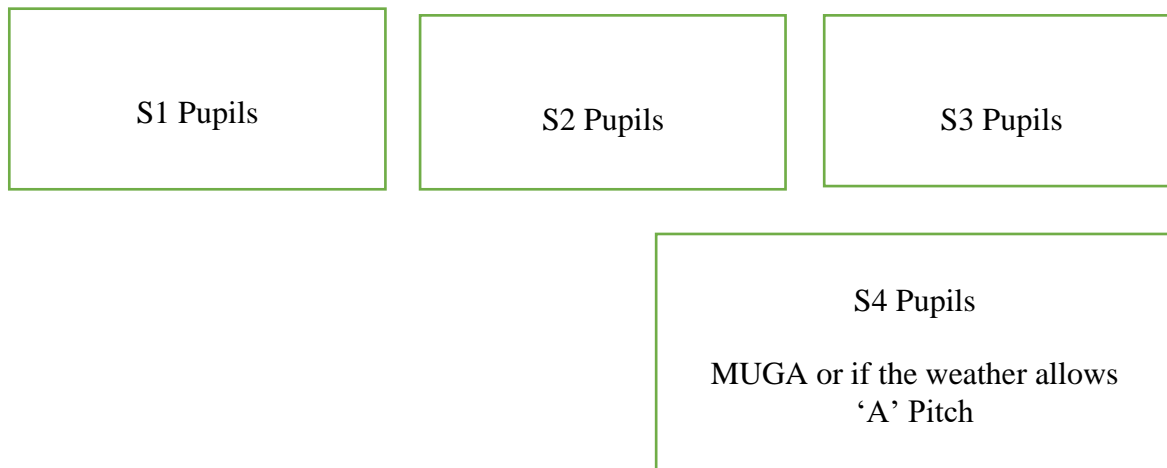

LUNCHTIME FOOTBALL LOCATIONS AND RULES

3G pitch
