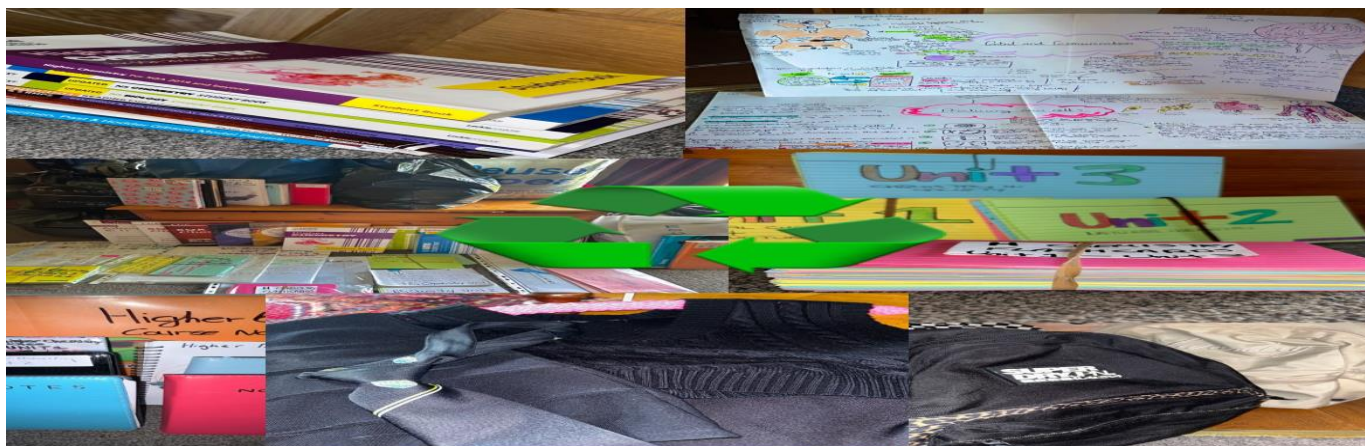
S4 SILVER DUKE of EDINBURGH
