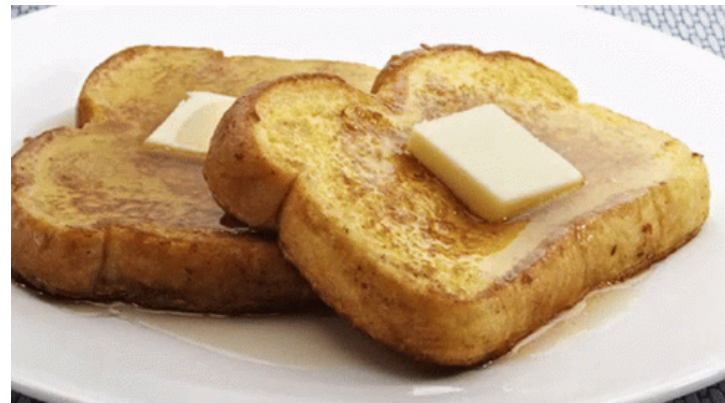


BREAKFAST CLUB


