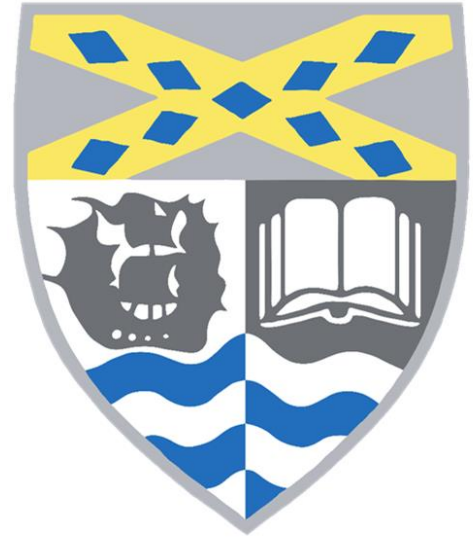

- This is open to all S4-S6. Those doing netball for their one off performances for PE performances should be attending this for practice.

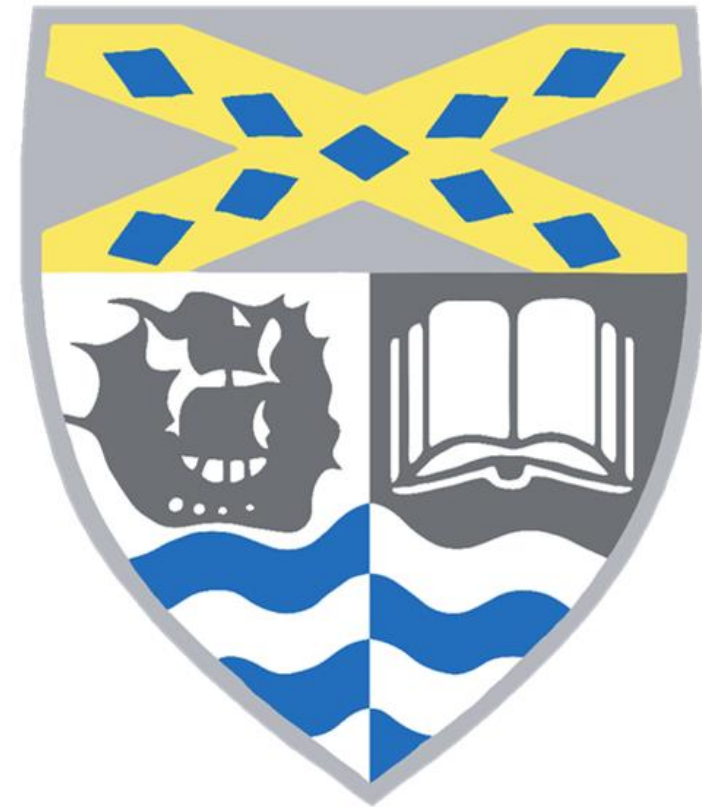
Notice – FAO S1–S6 Pupil Council Members

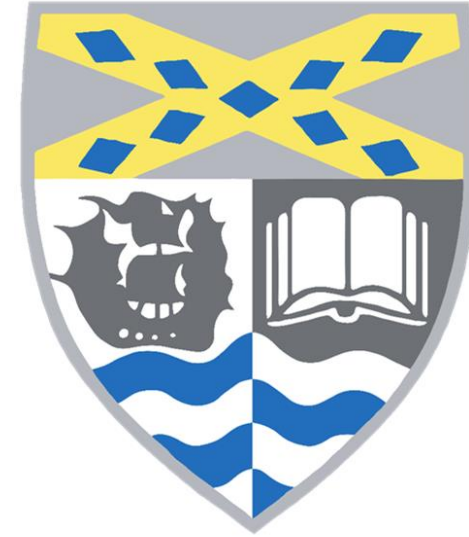
BREAKFAST CLUB
