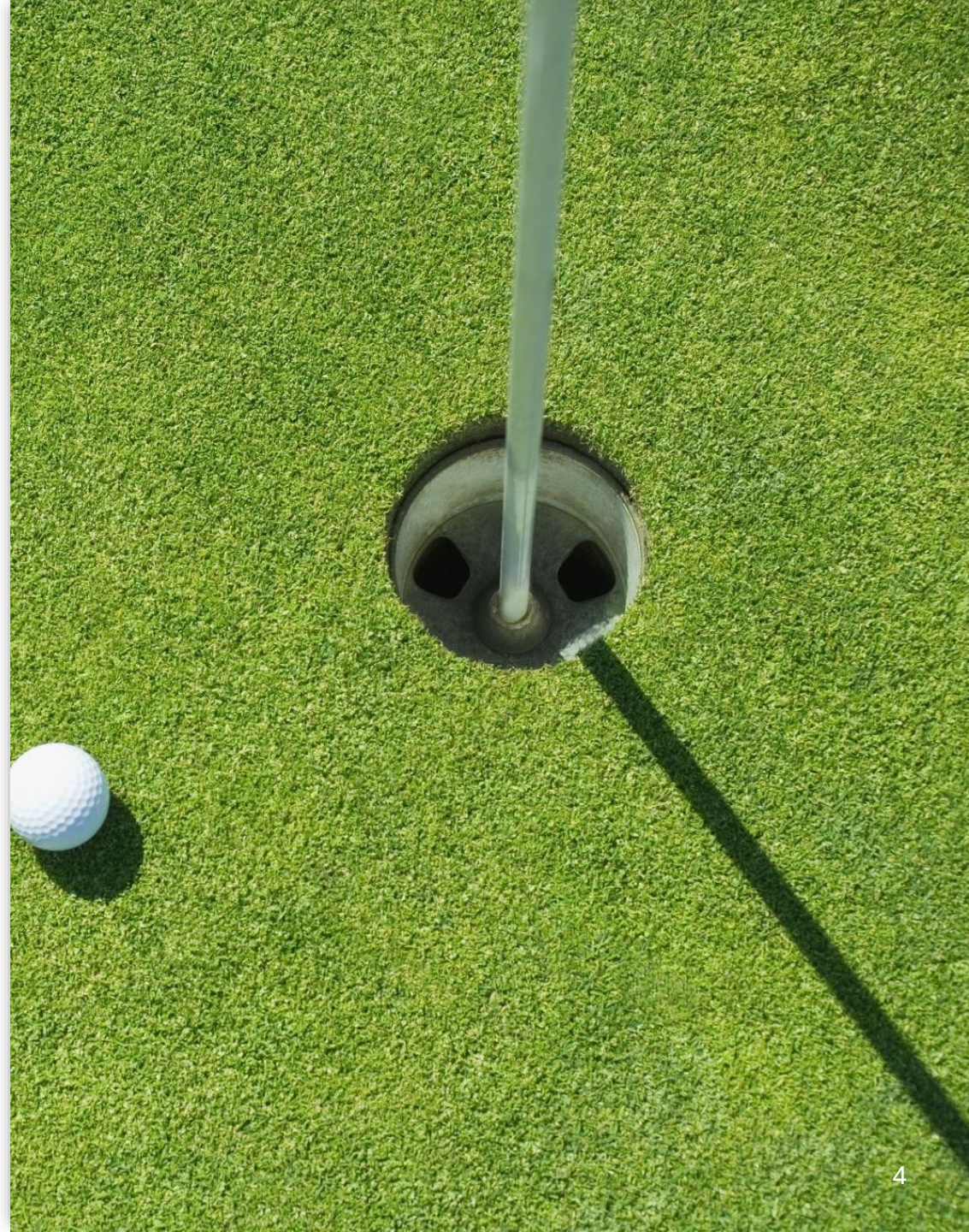
# Canteen
